Official Rules:

- Artist must be a Tk-8th grade Buckeye Union School District student.
- All kinds of art are welcome! Art must be completed <u>entirely by the student</u>, though use of any art supplies and tools (including tutorials) is allowed.
- Artist may submit multiple entries. (Enter as many works of art as you would like!)
- Artist must have parent/guardian permission to enter. Parent/guardian grants permission by submitting student's entry via parent/guardian email.
- Entries must be received on or before Sunday, November 30, 2025.
- To enter:
 - Take a clear picture of your artwork in .jpg or .png format, and email it to events@buckeyefoundation.org, along with the following information:
 - Grade-level
 - School
 - Teacher (middle school students can list First, Focus or AR teacher)
 - Title of Artwork
 - Medium or technique used (i.e. crayon on paper; acrylic on canvas; clay sculpture; etc. ANY medium you choose is allowed!)
 - Brief Artist Note (This optional, <u>one short sentence</u>, should tell the viewer about your art. For example, you can state the inspiration for your artwork, or let viewers know if there's a message you are trying to share with the world through your art.)
- Art will be scored based on the following:
 - Creativity
 - Visual Appeal
 - Use of Medium (how well you used your chosen materials, including technique, neatness, and craftsmanship)
 - Composition (how well you filled the space)
 - Interpretation of the theme "What I'm Grateful For"
- The top scoring artist in each grade level will receive the top honor and grade-level prize package. Scoring will take place during the week(s) following the submission deadline, with honors announced as soon as possible thereafter. All participants will receive a certificate of participation delivered to their classrooms.
