Theme: "What Lifts Me Up"

Deadline to enter: Friday, September 24, 2021

Official Rules:

- Artist must be a Tk-8th grade Buckeye Union School District student.
- All kinds of art are welcome! Art must be completed <u>entirely by the student</u>, though use of any art supplies and tools (including online tutorials) IS allowed.
- Artists may submit multiple entries! (Enter as many times as you would like!)
- Artist must have parent/guardian permission to enter. Parent/guardian shows permission by submitting student's entry via parent/guardian email.
- Entries must be received by 11:59 PM on Friday, September 24, 2021.
- To enter:
 - Take a clear picture of your artwork in .jpg or .png format, and email it to events@buckeyefoundation.org, along with the following information:
 - Artist's Information
 - Grade-level
 - School
 - Teacher
 - Title of Artwork
 - Medium or technique used (i.e. crayon on paper; acrylic on canvas; clay sculpture; etc. - ANY medium you choose is allowed!)
 - Artist Note (This is optional but helpful. Tell the viewer about your art for example: What was the inspiration for your artwork? Is there a message you are trying to share with the world? What is your artistic process?)
- Art will be scored based on the following:
 - Creativity
 - Visual Appeal
 - Use of Medium (how well you used your chosen materials, including technique, neatness, and craftsmanship)
 - Composition (how well you filled the space)
 - Interpretation of the theme "What Lifts Me Up"
- The top scoring artist in each grade level will receive the top honor and prize package. In the event of a tied score, a tie-breaker round of judging will be conducted.
- All participants will receive a certificate of participation!
